5. Contributes to the development and revision of departmental and student policies in relation to administration, admission, retention, evaluation, progression, graduation, and licensure
6. Assists in the development and evaluation of the Program's Strategic Plan and the budget and in planning and decision making regarding major expenditures
7. Acts in accord with the Program's professional and ethical standards
8. Participates in groups designed to involve community agencies in program planning and evaluation
9. Accepts leadership responsibilities within the Program
10. Participates in the recruitment of qualified faculty and students

11. Supervises the activities of adjunct lab instructors, if utilized

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

1. Selects, plans, organizes and implements learning experiences in assigned courses which assist students to meet course and program outcomes
2. Demonstrates thorough knowledge of the subject matter
