The Doctor of Physical Therapy program at Adventist University of Health Sciences (ADU), in Orlando, FL, is pleased to invite applications for an additional full-time faculty position, beginning summer of 2018. Rank and salary will be commensurate with education and teaching experience.

ADU, a Candidate for Accreditation, enrolled its first cohort in May, 2016. As the program continues to grow, we are seeking an additional member to join the seven members of the existing core faculty. ADU is a faith-based institution committed to educating health professionals from diverse backgrounds who are prepared to extend the healing ministry of Christ by providing optimal patient care.

The Doctor of Physical Therapy Program at ADU offers substantial opportunity for collegiality within the department and among other health professions, including occupational therapy, nursing, and physician's assistants. The small program size of 23 students per cohort allows faculty and students to develop close working relationships with ample time for teaching, mentorship, clinical practice, and research. This often includes working at the Hope Clinic, a community-based outpatient health and rehabilitation facility dedicated to addressing the needs of underserved individuals. Faculty and students also participate in annual international service learning experiences. New facilities at ADU include state-of-the-art simulation using standardized patients and the latest medical technology. In addition, the R.A. Williams Library features an extensive collection of health-related journals and databases, as well as many titles available in electronic text. As a health professions' university associated with the highly ranked Florida Hospital, ADU provides a multitude of collaborative clinical practice and research opportunities.

Description:

Requirements for the successful applicant are: academic doctoral degree (PhD, EdD, or equivalent) or a Doctor of Physical Therapy degree with clinical specialist credential, and an established record of teaching and scholarly work. Commitment to the ADU mission is essential. Preference will be given to an individual with established expertise to teach in at least one of the following areas: Pediatric PT, Biomechanics, or Musculoskeletal PT. All qualified candidates with a commitment to teaching excellence and advancing scholarly work are encouraged to apply. The candidates must be eligible for licensure as a physical therapist in Florida.
