Description: Qualifications: Candidates must be licensed or eligible for licensure in Maryland, have an earned doctoral degree (PhD, EdD, DSc, DHS, DPT), and have a minimum of three years of experience as a Clinical Instructor and/or clinical coordinator. Previous experience as a DCE preferred but not required. Candidates must demonstrate effective communication, organization skills, problem-solving, and the ability to work within a diverse ethnic and cultural setting. Must be able to travel to clinical sites.
