The main Oakland campus, where the DPT program is located, is in the east side of the beautiful and diverse San Francisco Bay area, and houses the state-of-the-art Movement Analysis Research Center (MARC) and Health Science Simulation Centers (HSSC).

Responsibilities: Teach entry-level DPT students in areas of expertise; participate in scholarship according to CAPTE requirements; and participate in department, university, professional and community service in areas of interest and expertise. Applicants interested in or familiar with the use of technology in innovative teaching and instructional design, and/or development of residency/fellowship programs are ideal.

The position is a twelve-month, full-time appointment as an Assistant or Associate Professor. The program enrolls approximately 38 students each year into our full-time, three-year program. The curriculum places an emphasis on integrated active learning experiences throughout the students' matriculation, during didactic semesters and through extensive clinical experiences.

Description: **Qualifications:** Applicants must be licensed or currently eligible for licensure in California. Contemporary expertise and teaching experience in musculoskeletal physical therapy management is required. Additional teaching experience in therapeutic exercise, evidence-based practice as applied to supervision of students' systematic review and/or case report capstone projects, and electrotherapeutic and biophysical agents is also preferred. Other areas of contemporary expertise will also be considered. Applicants with an academic doctorate (PhD or equivalent) in physical therapy or a related area of study and prior academic faculty experience are preferred. Applicants with a post-professional DPT and clinical specialization will also be considered.

Timeline: Application reviews will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Salary is competitive and commensurate with experience. Rank is commensurate with experience and credentials.
