This tenure-track eligible faculty position is a 12-month appointment and will begin in January, 2018.

Qualified candidates will hold an earned doctorate (Ph.D. in human anatomy, MD/DO with expanded formal training in the anatomical sciences) with at least three years' postgraduate experience teaching in the disciplines of human clinical gross anatomy, human physiology, histology, embryology, and neurology. Experience in teaching graduate courses within the health sciences is preferred. Successful candidates must demonstrate exceptional ability in teaching and the potential to contribute to research, service, and grant-writing at the university. The ideal candidate will have current knowledge of health sciences education and record of scholarship that fits with the mission of Samford University and the School of Health Professions. A commitment to academic excellence and the ability to work effectively with faculty, students and colleagues is expected. Candidates must be willing to support the Christian mission of Samford University and the College of Health Sciences.
