Description:

The Department of Physical Therapy at Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia invites applications for a 12-month senior faculty position in our evolving department. We seek a an academic researcher to join our dynamic department that values innovative education, active pursuit of scholarship, and engagement in community-based service.

Candidates must have an earned academic doctorate and be eligible for licensure as a physical therapist in Pennsylvania. Academic rank and salary are commensurate with qualifications. Expectations for teaching and service are negotiable relative to level of extramural funding.

The diverse translational and clinical research activities across the Thomas Jefferson University community and Jefferson Health System afford opportunities for collaboration. Currently the faculty are engaged in musculoskeletal rehabilitation research, neurorehabilitation translational and clinical research, as well as the education research inclusive of the scholarship of teaching and learning. The Department features research laboratory spaces and state of the art instrumentation in addition to 5,000 sq. feet of classrooms and teaching laboratories.

The faculty within the Department of Physical Therapy embrace a culture of academic and clinical excellence through interprofessional education and practice, innovative teaching in the Hamilton Clinical Simulations Center, and integrated experiential learning within the Jefferson Health system and outside clinical partners. The Department of Physical Therapy consists of 14 full-time faculty, clinical laboratory instructors and student enrollment of 180 students. The Department of Physical Therapy is an integral part of the Jefferson College of Health Professions (JCHP) which also includes the departments of Bioscience Technologies, Family and Couple Therapy, General Studies, Occupational Therapy, Physician Assistant and Radiologic Sciences.

Thomas Jefferson University, an academic health center, was founded as Jefferson Medical College in 1824. Today, this academic health center tests and treats 42,000 inpatients and more than 460,000 outpatients every year, and enrolls 3,600 future health care professionals. Public and private funding of Jefferson research exceeds \$64 million annually.
