The primary teaching opportunities for this position are specific to knowledge and expertise in patient management including general and specialized populations, examination and evaluation, prosthetics and orthotics, integumentary physical therapy, physical agents, and adjunct modalities. The ideal candidate will have a substantial amount of broad clinical experience with a variety of patient populations in a variety of clinical settings.

The University of the Pacific in Northern California has offered concise programs culminating in an accredited degree in physical therapy for 30 years, and began offering the DPT degree in 2003. The successful candidate will join a department of dynamic full-time and adjunct clinical faculty dedicated to preparing our students to be physical therapists and leaders who will have purposeful, meaningful, and positive impacts on health and society.

Description:
