The Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) Program in the Henrietta Schmoll School of Health invites applicants for the position of Open Faculty Position Assistant or Associate Professor of Physical Therapy and a half-time Ranked Faculty Physical Therapy beginning in August 2018.

**Responsibilities:** Primary responsibilities include team teaching in our dynamic integrated curriculum; establishment of an active research agenda; involvement with ongoing curriculum development, implementation and evaluation; participation in student academic and research advising/mentoring; and service on department and university committees as well as to the profession.

The physical therapist education program at St. Catherine began in 1991 and has enrolled Doctor of Physical Therapy students since 2003. The mission of the DPT Program is to educate students to lead and influence within the physical therapy profession. To this end, all DPT faculty members are expected to serve as role models for our students.

**Required Qualifications** for the Assistant or Associate Professor are: Candidates must have an earned DPT with ABPTS specialist certification, an earned academic Doctoral degree (PhD, EdD, or DSc) or be enrolled as an advanced doctoral candidate as ABD or currently enrolled in a doctoral program and have a minimum of five years clinical/physical therapy experience to be considered. Eligibility for physical therapist licensure in MN is also required. Teaching experience, clinical expertise in geriatrics and/or general practice physical therapy with a related specialty certification as well as an interest in and commitment to service learning is highly recommended. The DPT Program is committed to teaching and mentoring a diverse student population. Demonstrated success in working with diverse populations is preferred.

**Description:** **Qualifications** for the Ranked Faculty Physical Therapy position are: Candidates must have an earned DPT with ABPTS orthopedic or sports specialist certification, an earned academic doctoral degree (PhD, EdD, or DSc), or be currently enrolled in a doctoral program with significant progress toward completion. Eligibility for physical therapist licensure in MN and a minimum three years of orthopedic physical therapy experience is also required. Highly regarded applicants will have clinical expertise in orthopedic and sports physical therapy with teaching experience and an interest in and commitment to service learning. The DPT Program is committed to teaching and mentoring a diverse student population. Demonstrated success in working with diverse populations is preferred.
