The Arcadia University Department of Physical Therapy is currently recruiting for 2 full time, 9-month tenure track faculty positions. The department offers an entry level Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) degree, a dual degree with public health (DPT/MPH), post-professional DPT programs, and an Orthopaedic Residency. We are ranked among the top physical therapy programs in the country.

We invite physical therapists that hold academic doctorates to apply. Preference will be given to candidates with a well-conceived research agenda judged to be synergistic with current faculty interests and potential for securing extramural funding. Research in the department is funded by NIA, NIAMS, NCMRR, and various foundations. Scholarship broadly ranges in topics from shoulder dysfunction, to hip fracture, Down Syndrome and stroke. Opportunities exist for research collaboration with several large healthcare systems in the area. Capable, effective teaching in areas of content expertise is expected and occurs within a highly integrated curriculum. The faculty is committed to working in a collegial environment that values scholarship and professional service.

Responsibilities

The curriculum is highly integrative with specific content presented in 3-week modules organized around a case example or focus area. The curriculum is designed to move from simple to complex and to allow for repetition of concepts with increasing depth of knowledge. Thus, teaching responsibilities will be tailored to the clinical expertise of the candidate and the needs of the curriculum. The successful candidate will be expected to be involved in ongoing curriculum implementation and evaluation; serve on university-wide committees; advise students; and maintain an active research agenda.
