**Job Title:** Chair Of The Physical Therapy Doctoral Program

The University of Findlay invites nominations and applications for the position of **Chair of the Physical Therapy Doctoral Program**. The Physical Therapy Program, located in the College of Health Professions, offers the entry-level Doctor of Physical Therapy degree matriculating 36 students each year *in each program*. The Program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE), and currently has 13 faculty positions and a complement of clinical adjunct faculty positions. Students in the DPT program are offered two options through The University of Findlay: Traditional Program or the Weekend College Program.

**THE CHAIR:** Reporting to the Dean of the College of Health Professions, the Chair of the Program will work closely with all academic colleagues, most notably with P.T. faculty, to enhance the ongoing development of the Physical Therapy doctoral program. While she or he provides effective leadership for the program, including the responsibility for program assessment and planning, fiscal management and faculty evaluation, the department operates effectively as a self-governed unit. This position is a full-time tenure track 12 month appointment.

**POSITION REQUIREMENTS** – The successful candidate will have the following qualifications: An earned terminal degree (evidence of other professional qualifications – e.g. ABPTS or other specialty certification – would distinguish the candidate); Eligibility and willingness to gain licensure as a physical therapist in Ohio; Has the requisite experience necessary to be awarded the rank of associate or full professor; A minimum of six years of full time experience in a higher education environment; some experience in clinical education is preferred; A minimum of three years of full time experience in a physical therapist education program; Experience and knowledge in a supervisory role is required, with preference given to academic administrative experience; Prior college teaching experience is required and graduate level preferred; A record of scholarly research; Strong communication, organization, interpersonal, problem-solving and counseling skills; and a commitment to innovation, improvement and student-centered engaged learning.
