Allen College in Waterloo, Iowa is seeking two full-time faculty members for its new Doctor of Physical Therapy Program. One position is for the role of professional practice coordinator and one position is a core faculty position. Preferred qualifications include teaching experience in a DPT program (both positions), expertise in neuromuscular physical therapy or neuroscience (core faculty position), and experience as a center coordinator of clinical education (professional practice coordinator position). Start date for the positions is Fall 2018.

Sample of Core Faculty Position Responsibilities:

Participate in the development, coordination, implementation and evaluation of individual courses and overall curriculum within the college

Teaching:

Classroom and clinical preparation, instruction, supervision and evaluation.

Other activities directly related to the academic program.

Participate in scholarly activities (may include the following):

Ongoing study and research to maintain expertise, proficiency and growth in one's field of professional specialization.

Write, edit, and review texts and articles.

Serve as a consultant in the profession.

Attend and participate in meetings, conferences and conventions of professional associations.

Sample of Professional Practice Coordinator Position Responsibilities:

Acquire professional practice placements for new DPT program

Serve as the primary liaison with the program's professional practice sites.

Assure a sufficient number and variety of professional practice placements.

Place students in appropriate practice environments.

Maintain ongoing communication with professional practice sites.

Conduct ongoing assessment of the professional practice portion of the curriculum.

Description: Assure development needs of the professional practice faculty are being met.

Minimum Qualifications:

Doctoral preparation from a regionally accredited institution of higher education.

Licensure as a physical therapist in any US jurisdiction and eligibility for licensure in Iowa.

Demonstrated effectiveness in teaching and student evaluation.

Three years full-time clinical experience. Applicants for the position of Professional Practice Coordinator must also have two years' experience as a CCCE or CI for Physical Therapy students.

Preferred Qualifications:

Five years of clinical experience.

PhD or EdD.

Experience in curriculum and course development.

Experience in CAPTE accreditation process.

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Recent dissemination of scholarship.

ABPTS Specialist Certification.

Five years teaching experience in a DPT program and expertise in neuroscience and neurorehabilitation content (Core Faculty position).
