A search is underway for the Chair of the Physical Therapy Department and Director of the DPT Program. The DPT Program at Wingate University is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy (CAPTE). The department offers a Clinical Residency in Neurological Physical Therapy accredited by the American Board of Physical Therapy Residency and Fellowship Education (ABPTRFE) in conjunction with Atrium Health.

The Doctor of Physical Therapy Program complements the health sciences offerings of Wingate University Levine College of Health Sciences including Nursing, Pharmacy, and Physician Assistant Studies. A Doctor of Occupational Therapy Program will begin Fall 2019. The Wingate University DPT Program strives to be nationally recognized as a leader in the education of physical therapists. It seeks to reach this goal by providing a state-of-the-art, high-tech learning environment that facilitates critical thinking and problem solving skills, scholarly inquiry and service to the institution, the profession, and the community.

Wingate, a comprehensive, independent and growing university, serves more than 3,600 students in North Carolina. Founded in 1896, the University offers 37 undergraduate majors as well as graduate and professional programs. 15. Participating as a member of the Graduate Affairs Committee.
16. Participating in university-wide events.
17. Represent the Wingate University Division of Health Sciences and the Department of Physical Therapy outside the University.

Position Requirements:

Education and Experience. A terminal doctoral degree (Ph.D or Ed.D.) and either licensed in or eligible for licensure as a physical therapist in NC are required. At least 6 years of academic experience and the rank of Associate Professor, at a minimum, are required.

Communication Skills. Excellent written and verbal communication skills are essential. Must be able to develop and deliver oral presentations to diverse audiences. Must be able to present complex academic information clearly and effectively to various audiences, including the Wingate University community, the general public, prospective students, and their families.

Reasoning Abilities. Ability to read, analyze and interpret common numeric data. Must be able to define problems, collect data, establish facts and draw valid conclusions to resolve problems and plan initiatives.

Other Qualifications. Demonstrated ethical behavior, professionalism, interpersonal skills, leadership, and management abilities sufficient to fulfill the mandates of the job.
