We are looking for a dynamic, dedicated person who is willing to be involved in teaching, scholarly activity, and university/community service to complement our current faculty. The teaching/research responsibilities for the advertised position could be in one of a variety of areas including orthopedics, biomechanics, kinesiology, pharmacology, integumentary physical therapy/wound healing, motor control, or health administration. Additionally, the successful candidate must demonstrate classroom/laboratory teaching experience and research experience with an ability to generate extramural funding. We value candidates with experience working with disadvantaged student populations.

Required qualifications include: 1) earned PhD degree (or comparable research-based doctorate degree, 2) postdoctoral fellowship or equivalent formal research mentoring experience, 3) active member of the APTA if a PT, 4) team player with strong communication, organization, interpersonal, and problem-solving skills.

Preferred qualifications include: degree in Physical Therapy, PhD and eligible for PT licensure in Wisconsin.

Description:
