Director, Rehabilitation

Saint Francis University invites applications for the position of Director, Rehabilitation for the Faculty-Student practice in the DiSepio Institute for Rural Health and Wellness at Saint Francis University. The Director is responsible to the Director of DiSepio to organize and deliver rehabilitation services, responding to the needs of the patients referred from the University and broader communities. Work collaboratively with the faculty and service directors e.g. Athletic Training, Student Health Center personnel, etc to assure the appropriate delivery of rehabilitation services. Works collaboratively with the Physical Therapy Department's Academic Coordinator of Clinical Education to provide clinical instruction to student physical therapists. Works collaboratively with the director of residency and fellowship programs to provide didactic and clinical instruction and assessment. Also may perform academic instruction in the Department of Physical Therapy Program up to .4 FTE.

Description:

An DPT degree and PA licensure as a physical therapist are required. A certificate of authorization to practice physical therapy without a referral in PA is required. Three years of clinical experience is required; five to 10 years of clinical experience is preferred. ABPTS specialty in sports (SCS) or orthopedics (OCS) is required; certification as an athletic trainer (ATC) or an orthopedic manual therapist (COMT) or a Certified Hand Therapist (CHT) or similar from a recognized professional certifying organization is preferred. Experience as a clinic manager is required; one year's experience as an administrative manager is preferred. Experience delivering clinical inservices is required; experience as a clinical instructor (CI) is preferred. Experience promoting clinical services is required; marketing responsibility for a clinical service line is preferred. Teaching experience as a lab instructor or similar is required; experience as a course instructor is preferred. Knowledge of third-party rehabilitation reimbursement is required. Computer proficiency in word processing and spreadsheet applications is required; proficiency in database and presentation applications is preferred. Strong organizational, interpersonal, and communication skills and a demonstrated ability to develop cooperative and supportive relationships with colleagues are required. APTA/PPTA membership is required.
