The Department of Physical Therapy at the University of New England (<http://www.une.edu/wchp/pt/>) is currently inviting applications for a Visiting Assistant or Associate Professor. The position is a full-time, 9-month appointment with teaching and service required and will be available for hire beginning August 15, 2018. Application review will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. Start date is negotiable. Rank and salary are commensurate with qualifications.

Qualified applicants are physical therapists with clinical expertise in adult neurorehabilitation who are eligible for licensure in Maine. Preference will be given to candidates with ABPTS certification and/or prior university teaching experience.

Description:

Primary teaching responsibilities include serving as the lead course instructor and coordinator for two courses in the entry-level Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) program during the spring 2019 semester: (1) Pathology and Medical / Surgical Management of Adults with Neurological Health Conditions, and (2) PT Management of Adults with Neurological Health Conditions. Additional teaching responsibilities in areas of clinical or academic expertise may be assigned during the fall 2018 semester, depending on DPT program needs. The position also entails participation in department service activities.

UNE is a private, co-educational institution with two campuses on the southern Maine coast and a third campus in Tangier, Morocco. The Department of Physical Therapy is based on the historic Portland campus alongside health professions training programs in dental hygiene, dental medicine, nursing, nurse anesthesia, occupational therapy, pharmacy, physician assistant, and social work. Interprofessional education and service learning are hallmarks of campus culture. Additional health professions training programs (athletic training; applied exercise science; health, wellness, & occupational studies; nutrition; osteopathic medicine; and public health) are located on the nearby Biddeford, ME campus. Portland is Maine's business, financial, medical, and retail center, and one of the nation's most livable small cities. Its beautiful seaside location, approximately 100 miles north of Boston, MA, is within easy driving distance of inland lakes and mountains.
