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The USF Health School of Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Sciences (SPT&RS) announces a search for a **Director of Clinical Education at the Assistant/Associate/Professor level**. This full-time, 12-month position will **partner with the existing clinical education team** (Co-Coordinator of Professional Education, 2 Assistant Coordinators of Clinical Education, and administrative staff) in leading our clinical education program as an integral component within the DPT professional curriculum. The School seeks candidates who will direct and shape the clinical education vision and represents this vision to constituent groups internal and external to the program and university. The Director of Clinical Education is charged with developing strong clinical partnerships that support the SPT&RS education mission including academic excellence, simulation, and interprofessional education. She or he is responsible for the professional development of the clinical education team and clinical educators. Opportunities exist to partner in post-professional residency and/or fellowship programs. In addition, the Director of Clinical Education will actively participate in professional activities that influence clinical education. Faculty rank, salary and start-up packages are highly competitive and commensurate with academic qualifications. Position may be tenure-accruing or non-tenure accruing and will remain open until filled.

The University of South Florida is a Carnegie Tier 1 Research-Extensive university serving over 47,000 students in the Tampa Bay area. USF Health is a comprehensive academic health sciences center comprised of Colleges of Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, and Public Health along with SPT&RS, and Biomedical Sciences which provide outstanding opportunities for collaboration and research. SPT&RS DPT professional program enrolls up to 48 students per class each year. The School's state-of-the-art 6,000+-sq. ft. The School's clinical faculty provide clinical services at the USF Physical Therapy Center in collaboration with other healthcare specialties. Haley VA Hospital, Lakeland Health, Moffitt Cancer Center, and Tampa General Hospital,) offer clinical, educational, and research affiliations.

Administrative oversight and leadership of clinical education and team for the DPT professional curriculum.

Teaching within the DPT professional curriculum.

Scholarly and/or funded research activity as appropriate based on expertise.

Entry-level degree in Physical Therapy (BS, MS, or DPT) and doctoral preparation (DPT, PhD, EdD, DSc, etc.).

Eligibility for Physical Therapy licensure in the State of Florida.

Minimum 5 years' experience as a physical therapist and/or educator.

Description: Minimum 2 years' experience as a clinical instructor and/or CCCE.

Contemporary expertise in specific assigned teaching area.

For appointment as Associate Professor: minimum 5 years full-time appointed academic experience at Assistant Professor rank.
