Qualified candidates will have an academic doctoral degree, a minimum of 6 years teaching experience in physical therapy, and a documented record of peer-reviewed publications and grant submissions. Preference will be given to candidates currently at rank of associate or full professor. As a senior faculty member, there are expectations of mentoring junior faculty in scholarship and teaching, and providing senior faculty leadership. Candidates must be licensed or licensure-eligible to practice as a physical therapist in Colorado.

The School of Physical Therapy offers an entry-level Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) degree, a fellowship program in orthopedic manual therapy, and an undergraduate degree in Health & Exercise Science and a joint venture OTD program with Creighton University. The integrated DPT curriculum incorporates the study of movement as a core curricular foundation in a systems approach across the lifespan. Faculty teams, consisting of experts in various content areas teach and actively pursue scholarship, service, and clinical practice. The breadth and depth of our experienced faculty allows for exploration of innovative approaches to teaching and learning, as well as engagement in our profession and local and global communities. Interprofessional collaboration is encouraged in teaching and scholarship.
