Director - School of Physical Therapy

Touro University Nevada, College of Health and Human Services, School of Physical Therapy is seeking a 12-month full-time Director for the School Physical Therapy. This position is open due to planned retirement of the founding Director and is available July 1, 2013. An earlier start date is negotiable.

Primary responsibilities of the full-time appointment are to provide leadership and direction for the day to day activities of the physical therapy educational programs. The Director is responsible for ensuring compliance with local, state, and national accreditation/licensure for the School of Physical Therapy and coordinating all strategic planning and development activities for physical therapy. Fiscal management duties include budget development, oversight, and approval of expenditures for the program. The director is responsible for coordination of faculty development, student recruitment, admission, and retention, and curriculum review. The individual will be expected to provide instruction in his/her area of expertise and maintain a scholarly agenda which meets the requirement for maintenance of rank and CAPTE expectations.

Minimum Requirements:

Qualified applicants should have a post-professional doctoral degree (PhD, EdD, DSc) and be eligible for senior faculty status. A minimum of five years of progressive faculty and administrative experience, demonstrated expertise in a curricular area and a documented record of scholarly activity are required. The selected individual must be eligible for Nevada License as a physical therapist and secure full active licensure within six months of employment.
