Ten (10) month tenure-track faculty position at the assistant professor level, with separate summer contract for summer clinical coverage; begins August 15, 2013.

Required qualifications:

- Doctoral degree, either post-professional OR DPT with advanced clinical specialization;
- Physical therapy license, or license eligible, in Virginia;
- Experience supervising physical therapy students in clinical education activities, either in the academic or clinical environment;
- Strong organizational and interpersonal skills; ability to problem-solve and counsel students;
- Able to work well with clinical education faculty to meet the diverse needs of students.

Preferred qualifications:

- Familiarity with regulations governing clinical education and mechanisms to stay updated with these changing regulations;
- Clinical background in orthopedics or geriatrics is a plus;
- Active involvement in the APTA.

Responsibilities:

- Continued development, coordination, and evaluation of the clinical education program for an established DPT program;
- Teach one academic course each fall and spring semester;
- Engage in scholarship activities, consistent with University and CAPTE expectations for core faculty;
- Contribute to program and curriculum assessment and planning activities.

Description:

Setting

Marymount University, located in Arlington, Virginia, is a comprehensive, coeducational Catholic university serving nearly 4,000 undergraduate and graduate students. The physical therapy program is located at the University's Ballston Center, just 2 blocks from the Ballston metro, in an active and vibrant urban community.

The Program

The PT program uses a modified problem-based educational format and integrates clinical education experiences early in the curriculum. There are 38 students in each of three cohort groups in this 3 year, 9 semester program. The program has 8 full-time faculty members, and numerous adjunct

faculty who assist in problem-based tutorials and serve as lab assistants. We maintain over 300 clinical placements for our students, evenly distributed among local placements and placements across the country.
