They will report to the Dean of the School of Medicine, and have major responsibilities in the overall direction of this distinguished department.

The Department of Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Science develops physical therapist practitioners and scholars to restore physical function and performance, prevent physical injury and disease, and promote physical wellness.
