Applicants with previous experience as full time academic faculty and/or those credentialed as clinical specialists with recent teaching experience are preferred. Preferred content expertise: geriatrics, cardiopulmonary, wound care, pharmacology, pathology, and/or physiology. Experienced faculty across all content areas are encouraged to apply and will be considered. Clinical experience equivalent to at least 3 years of full time practice is preferred.
