The College of Health Sciences at Midwestern University invites applications for the position of Director of the Physical Therapy Program, on the Downers Grove, IL campus. The position is available for July 1, 2018. The Physical Therapy Program offers the degree of Doctor of Physical Therapy. The successful candidate will hold a post-professional doctoral degree in Physical Therapy or a related field and be eligible for Illinois state licensure in physical therapy. The candidate should document academic experience with a strong record of teaching and scholarly activity. The candidate should provide evidence of strong leadership; exceptional communication skills; an in-depth understanding of higher education, curricular design, assessment, and contemporary physical therapy clinical practice. Demonstrated administrative experience is highly preferred. The Program director's specific responsibilities include oversight of the budget, implementation of the curriculum and adherence to the accreditation standards, mentorship of the faculty, selected teaching in area of expertise, and oversight of the University Physical Therapy Clinic. The candidate should have the academic credentials commensurate with the faculty rank of Associate Professor or higher; this is a tenure-track position. Salary and benefits are competitive. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled.

Midwestern University is a not-for-profit institution of higher education committed to the education of health care professionals. The Illinois campus is located on a spacious 105-acre campus in Downers Grove, 25 miles west of Chicago, and is home to the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine, Chicago College of Pharmacy, College of Dental Medicine - Illinois, Chicago College of Optometry, and College of Health Sciences.
