Assistant Director of Clinical Education

Saint Francis University in Loretto, Pennsylvania invites applications for an Assistant Director of Clinical Education. The Assistant Director of Clinical Education is a, full-time, 10 month tenured faculty position in their entry-level Doctoral program. The Department of Physical Therapy is seeking a dynamic and dedicated individual interested in teaching in the program's progressive curriculum.

The Assistant Director for Clinical Education works collaboratively with the Director of Clinical Education in soliciting and developing sites, developing clinical faculty, conducting student site visits and remediation plans, enforcing policy, and carrying out teaching duties as assigned within clinical education and in area of practice expertise. Percent allocation is primarily for clinical education needs in administration and teaching. The preferred candidate will have knowledge of, and a background in, clinical education in an academic and/or clinical setting as well as a strong communication, organization and computer skills.

**Description:**

The successful candidate will engage in scholarship, which may be through the Human Performance Laboratory or Center for Rehabilitation in the DiSepio Institute for Rural Health and Wellness. Faculty will participate in service to the university, student advisement, and are encouraged to be involved in community outreach activities. Faculty clinical practice opportunities are available through the on-campus Center for Rehabilitation.

The successful candidate will hold a doctoral degree in Physical Therapy. The candidate should hold, or provide proof of eligibility for, licensure in Pennsylvania, with a minimum of 3 years of clinical practice, clinical teaching and/or clinical coordination experience. Must hold a valid driver's license and be able to travel overnight or for extended periods. Preferred qualifications include prior university level teaching experience, prior experience as a director of clinical coordination, active APTA membership, and experience in clinical education research design and implementation.
