Organizational Unit Overview

The College of Allied Health Sciences is an integral part of a vibrant medical campus including the Brody School of Medicine, the School of Dental Medicine, the College of Nursing, and the East Carolina Heart Institute. East Carolina University, the third largest university in the state (~29,000 students), is a constituent of the UNC system. ECU is located in Greenville, North Carolina (population ~91,000). Located approximately 1½ hours from the capital city of Raleigh, Greenville is the cultural, educational, medical, and economic center of eastern North Carolina and enjoys a temperate climate. Greenville is also within driving distance to the beautiful North Carolina beaches (2 hours) and mountains (4 hours).

The Department of Physical Therapy has a faculty practice clinic which provides opportunities for clinical practice and research, and a well-established collaborative relationship with Vidant Medical Center, a fully accredited, 1000+ bed regional hospital that serves 29 counties. Vidant encompasses a Level-1 trauma center and extensive inpatient and outpatient services including rehabilitation and pain management. Our DPT program has strong administrative support and attracts top quality students for each 30-student cohort.

Job Duties

The Department of Physical Therapy in the College of Allied Health Sciences at East Carolina University (ECU) invites applications for a 12-month tenure-track position at the Assistant, Associate, or Professor rank for a well-established Doctor of Physical Therapy program. East Carolina University seeks to create an environment that fosters the recruitment and retention of a diverse student body, faculty, staff, and administration. We strongly encourage applications from women, minorities, and historically underrepresented groups.

Successful candidates will be expected to establish a productive and fundable research agenda. Faculty have access to two well-equipped motion analysis labs (Balance Lab = 1000 ft², Human Movement Lab = 2000 ft²), containing a NeuroCom dynamic force plate system, a HUR balance platform, three 8-camera Qualisys systems, six AMTI force platforms, a split-belt Bertec fully instrumented treadmill, LiteGait bodyweight support system, and two 16 channel Motion Lab Systems EMG setups, a GaitRite system, and a Novel Insole Pressure system. Additionally, facilities are available and PT faculty are in place to collaborate on blood and tissue analysis research.

Description: Primary teaching responsibilities will be in neuromuscular/neuromotor evaluation and treatment with opportunities to teach in other areas of interest. Instructional facilities include fully equipped lecture and laboratory classrooms.

Earned or near-completion PhD or equivalent degree, teaching and/or clinical expertise in adult and/or pediatric neuromuscular evaluation and treatment, and eligibility for PT licensure in North Carolina.
