Overview

The Department of Physical Therapy at Marquette University is seeking a dynamic, highly motivated, and visionary Chairperson to continue to advance our highly ranked Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) program starting in July of 2018. The Department of Physical Therapy has great tradition and alumni support, graduating its first class in 1952. The Department is located within the heart of the campus of Marquette University, a Jesuit, Catholic University with 12,000 students, located near downtown Milwaukee, WI. We are seeking an applicant who has demonstrated a strong commitment towards the importance of the three tenets of undergraduate, graduate, and professional education at MU: teaching, research, and service. Our highly successful DPT Program, housed within the College of Health Sciences, is currently ranked in the top 10% of all PT programs and is accredited by CAPTE through 2026. The position is a permanent, full-time tenure track line at the associate professor or full professor level.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Chair directs multiple academic and clinical components within the Department of Physical Therapy, including the DPT Program, a master's degree and PhD program, a Program in Exercise Science which offers an undergraduate degree in exercise physiology and a master's degree in athletic training. The Chair also oversees the Marquette PT clinic, and the Marquette Neurological Residency program that is co-sponsored by the Zablocki VA Medical Center. This position requires direct or indirect supervision of twenty-two faculty, and six staff members across the programmatic and degree offerings.

In addition, the Chair has the following responsibilities, but not limited to:

Description: -Teach in one content area preferably from the following: neuroanatomy, pharmacology, wounds, diagnostic imaging, biomechanics, musculoskeletal conditions, or culture and disability.

-Advise students

-Manage CAPTE accreditation process; prepare departmental annual reporting and budget

-Guide alumni relations activities and fund-raising

-Lead Departmental strategic planning and assessment

-Oversee DPT admissions process and recruitment events; faculty hiring, development, and promotion

-Participate in and guide Departmental fund-raising including oversight of endowed funds
