The USF Health School of Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Sciences (SPT&RS) invites qualified individuals to apply for a New Faculty Position at the Assistant/Associate Professor level. This is a new 12-month, full-time (1.0 FTE) non-tenure or tenure-accruing faculty position and will remain open until filled. The School is seeking a dynamic individual with or without extramural grant funding and a strong publication record. The applicant is expected to have expertise in one or more of the following areas: acute care, anatomy, cardiovascular and pulmonary, ethics/professionalism, exercise physiology, integumentary, interprofessional education, or neuroscience. The focus of this position is to address the School's missions in teaching, research, and service.

Opportunities exist to partner in post-professional residency and/or fellowship programs. Faculty rank, salary, and start-up packages are highly competitive and commensurate with academic qualifications.
