Creighton University, a Catholic, Jesuit institution, invites applications for a full-time, non-tenured

12-month faculty position in the Department of Physical Therapy. This position is to serve as an Academic Coordinator of Clinical Education (ACCE) and an Instructor of Record (IOR) for Integrated Laboratory courses which are threaded across all semesters of a comprehensive entry-level curriculum. As an ACCE, this individual will serve with a team of faculty as an advisor and monitor student progression in clinical education through the program. As a lab coordinator/IOR this individual will collaborate with physical therapy faculty and residents to organize, implement and instruct specific content areas of the Integrated Lab courses. Scholarship and service is expected with faculty rank commensurate with experience.

The ideal candidate will possess expertise in leadership with strong organizational skills, successful collaboration with others, creativity and vision for future physical therapy practice, and an ability to integrate clinical competencies through team-based student learning. The candidate will have a minimum of 5 years of experience as a licensed physical therapist including service as a clinical instructor. A Doctor of Physical Therapy degree and eligibility for licensure in Nebraska are required. Certification as an APTA Credentialed Clinical Instructor or experience in laboratory teaching in an entry-level DPT program is strongly preferred. Preference is also given to those who possess or are interested in pursuing an academic doctorate. Cardiopulmonary or acute care expertise is desired. Additional skills in physical therapy practice, higher education, or specialty care will be considered.

**Description:**

The Department of Physical Therapy, with 19 core faculty members, is an integral part of a comprehensive health science campus. The Department is an established leader in entry-level physical therapy education, post-graduate residency programs, clinical reasoning, nationally-funded research laboratories (<http://rehablab.creighton.edu>) and service to the profession through academic excellence and scholarship.
