The Department of Physical Therapy at the University of Florida invites applications for a full-time tenure track Assistant Professor position. This new 12-month, full-time tenure-accruing position will involve research and scholarship in the applicant's area of expertise, and team teaching in the Doctorate of Physical Therapy program. The applicant is expected to have: 1) a focused research direction in the area of rehabilitation, 2) a strong publication record, 3) potential for extramural grant funding, and 4) a commitment to effective teaching. Applicants must hold a PhD or equivalent and be licensed or eligible for Physical Therapy licensure in the State of Florida. Applicants should be able to interact effectively with faculty from multiple disciplines, students and clinicians.

**Description:**

The Department of Physical Therapy is housed within the College of Public Health and Health Professions and is well integrated within the UF Health Science Center, providing a wealth of opportunities for scholarly collaborations. The UF Department of Physical Therapy currently holds in excess of 10 million dollars annually in extramural funding. Our faculty has access to clinical patient populations and work closely with clinicians across the UF system, Brooks Rehabilitation and the Veterans Administration. Our passionate faculty includes world leaders in rehabilitation science research and faculty are strongly committed to teaching forward thinking and evidenced-based practice. The UF Department of Physical Therapy was recently recognized by US News and World Report as a Top 10 physical therapy program. In the past 5 years the University of Florida has completed a nearly one billion dollar initiative to raise UF into the top 10 public research universities; UF was recently ranked 9<sup>th</sup> among major public research universities. Now the University has committed to hire 500 new faculty to continue the pursuit of academic excellence.

The successful candidate will be expected to begin their appointment no later than August 15, 2018. Individuals with diverse backgrounds are strongly encouraged to apply.
