POSITION: Tenure-Track Assistant/Associate Professor of Physical Therapy. This is a 12-month position.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach Physical Therapy clinical coursework in the classroom, clinical, laboratory and on-line, advise students, conduct collaborative and independent research, mentor student research and engage in department, college, university and professional service.

THE DEPARTMENT: The Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation offers several distinctive programs: Physical Therapy (Doctorate), Physician Assistant Studies (Master's), Occupational Therapy (Master's), Athletic Training (Doctorate, Master's, Bachelor's), and Massage Therapy (Minor) and provides healthcare to student-athletes and the public through the Physical Therapy and Sports Rehabilitation Clinic and ISU's Intercollegiate Athletic Training Services.

THE PROGRAM: The DPT program at Indiana State University is a fully CAPTE accredited DPT program, and recently admitted its 4th cohort. The program currently admits 30 students/year, has reasonable teaching loads, and an extensive commitment to community engagement. The program moved into the new, state-of-the-art College of Health and Human Services Building in April of 2018. The program has access to stellar simulation facilities which are utilized in multiple courses.

QUALIFICATIONS: Doctorate (DPT, PhD, Ed.D., etc) required. ABD will be considered, but degree must be completed by July 1, 2019. Current licensure as a physical therapist in the state of Indiana, or eligible to obtain licensure by July 1, 2019. Relevant clinical experience required. Individuals meeting the criteria at either rank, by the date of opening, are encouraged to apply. Individuals with expertise in acute care, basic skills, pharmacology, wound care and clinical education are preferred.
