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Teaching Positions in the USC Residential and Hybrid online/on-campus DPT Program

Open Rank: Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Instructor

The **University of Southern California's Division of Biokinesiology and Physical Therapy** invites applications for part-time, exempt, clinical faculty teaching positions in the entry level DPT program. Rank and salary are commensurate with experience and qualifications. Faculty hired at 50% time are benefits eligible.

The high priority positions are as **Course Director** of two courses: Electrophysiology (1 unit lab course), and Therapeutic Application of Physical Agents (2 units lab and lecture). All courses are taught in both an on-campus and hybrid online/on-campus format. The course director is responsible for planning and implementing the courses, assessing the students' learning outcomes, supervising supporting faculty instructors, and participating in student advisement. The course director will work with the hybrid course lead in translating the residential courses into the hybrid online/on-campus format and ensure consistency between both. Ideal candidates for this position will have clinical and teaching expertise in these content areas, but applicants with expertise in other areas of instruction will be considered. A single individual teaching both courses is preferred.

In addition, positions are open for the **Course Lead** in the hybrid on-line/on-campus program's Electrophysiology and Therapeutic Application of Physical Agents courses. Responsibilities include working with the course director to plan and translate the courses into the hybrid format, implementing the hybrid courses, supervising faculty instructors, and assessing the students' learning outcomes. Ideal candidates for this position will have clinical and teaching expertise in these content areas, but applicants with expertise in other areas of instruction will be considered. A single individual teaching both courses is preferred.

Positions are also open for **laboratory Instructors** in three Spring Semester courses: Therapeutic Exercise, Neurologic Patient Management and Orthopedic Patient Management. Ideal candidates for these positions will have clinical and teaching expertise in neurologic or orthopedic rehabilitation, but applicants with expertise in other areas of instruction will be considered. Preference will be given to candidates with ABPTS certification, residency and/or fellowship training, and/or prior university teaching experience.

Description:

USC's Division of Biokinesiology and Physical Therapy has a long history and a strong reputation for excellence and leadership in physical therapy education. The Division's scholarly and research programs support two educational programs: Biokinesiology (PhD and MS) and Physical Therapy (DPT), four accredited physical therapy residency programs and one accredited clinical fellowship program. The faculty direct a total of 14 research labs and many hold secondary appointments within the USC Keck School of Medicine, the university-wide Neuroscience Graduate Program, the Viterbi School of Engineering, and the Children's Hospital of Los Angeles. The Division also has an extensive clinical service, comprising over 50 clinical faculty with diverse clinical specialties practicing in three locations: Keck Hospitals and our two faculty practices.

Application Procedure:

Application review will begin immediately and will continue until the positions are filled. Qualified applicants will submit: (1) a letter of interest stating the which position the applicant will apply for, and outlining experience in classroom instruction, course/curriculum development, and student advisement; and (2) a current curriculum vitae. Interviews will be scheduled based on the qualifications of the applicant pool, at which time three letters of recommendation will be required.
