Applications are invited for a 12-month full-time/tenure track physical therapy faculty position. Rank, salary and tenure status are commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Responsibilities and Qualifications for Assistant Professor – Physical

Therapy: Faculty responsibilities include teaching in the candidate's area of expertise, scholarly activity, university/professional service, curriculum evaluation, and student mentoring. Applicants with a post-professional doctoral degree (e.g., PhD, EdD, DSc, DHS) and evidence of scholarly preparation are preferred. Individuals with a Doctor of Physical Therapy degree, specialist certification and a strong desire to complete a post-professional doctorate degree in the near future are encouraged to submit an application. Applicants should be eligible for physical therapy licensure in Illinois, and have at least 3 years of clinical experience. A record of prior teaching experience, scholarly productivity, and professional service will enhance the candidate's application. Preference will be given to candidates whose background and experience build on the expertise of the current faculty members.
