The Department of Physical Therapy and Human Movement Sciences (PTHMS) within the Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine invites applications for a full-time faculty position, in the non-tenure, clinician-educator track, in the area of musculoskeletal physical therapy. Primary responsibilities will include teaching in the musculoskeletal course series in the Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) curriculum, teaching/mentoring in the Orthopaedic Physical Therapy Residency (a joint program with the Shirley Ryan AbilityLab), and team teaching in other foundational DPT courses. Additional responsibilities of the position include scholarship, student advising, and service on departmental committees. There is also opportunity for clinical practice.

Rank is commensurate with experience and credentials. Salary is negotiable. The ideal applicant will be a physical therapist eligible for Illinois licensure, with an earned DPT, PhD or other academic doctorate and clinical specialization in orthopaedic or sports physical therapy (or other advanced specialization certification equivalent). Preference will be given to applicants with residency and/or fellowship training with evidence of strong scholarship, and with the ability to mentor orthopaedic residents in scholarly work. Applicants should demonstrate a successful record of developing course content and teaching orthopedic physical therapy in entry-level physical therapy curricula and/or the post-professional level. In this position, the candidate will also be expected to contribute to our high quality team-teaching program that is innovative, concept-structured, based on scientific evidence, and emphasizes active student learning.

**Description:**

PTHMS is part of the vibrant educational and cultural community of Northwestern University located on the Chicago campus of Northwestern University close to Lake Michigan and the "Magnificent Mile". PTHMS also has collaborations with the Departments of Biomedical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Communications and Sciences Disorders, Orthopaedic and Neurologic Surgery, Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, Neurology, Emergency Medicine, Radiology, Physiology, and Oncology. The successful applicant is expected to foster existing and new inter-departmental relationships.
