The Department of Physical Therapy at Hardin-Simmons University welcomes applicants who have a love for clinical education & teaching, as well as a heart for service, to serve as our Director of Clinical Education (DCE). The interested candidate would join a dynamic faculty dedicated to the success of our entry-level DPT students. Faculty and students are involved in pro-bono PT clinical mission work locally, within Texas and abroad. The DCE works directly with the DPT students to place them in high quality clinical experiences in a variety of settings, obtain and maintain clinical contracts, and promotes excellence, integrity and service. Some teaching is expected and related to the candidate's strengths and talents. The successful candidate must have a DPT degree, a minimum of 3 years' experience as a licensed physical therapist (eligible for Texas licensure), a minimum of 2 years of clinical experience as the Clinical Coordinator of Clinical Education (CCCE) or as a Clinical Instructor (CI) for DPT students, or 2 years of experience in teaching, curriculum development and administration in a PT program. Strong communication, organizational, interpersonal, problem-solving, and perceptiveness skills are required. Candidates are expected to have (or develop) a planned program of scholarly pursuits, mentor physical therapy students, and participate in service to the department, university, profession and/or community.

Description: Hardin-Simmons University is a private, faith-based institution whose mission is to provide students with "an education enlightened by faith." Located in Abilene, this beautiful campus in West Texas offers a supportive, mentoring environment for faculty. The Physical Therapy Department will be moving to a beautiful new facility this summer with expansive classrooms, laboratories and new equipment. This is a full-time, 12-month, tenure track position at the Assistant or Associate Professor level available June 1, 2018 and requires some travel.
