Teaching responsibilities will be dependent on qualifications. Rank and salary are commensurate with experience.

Finalists for the position will be invited to interview in the first quarter of 2018.

**Responsibilities:** The faculty position involves administrative, academic, service and scholarship responsibilities consistent with the mission and philosophy of the Program, School and Institution. Faculty are responsible for developing learning content, executing that content and evaluating student performance in the didactic curriculum. In addition to teaching responsibilities, faculty are expected to engage in research and other scholarly activities, clinical practice, and professional activities.
