Minimum Qualifications:

- * Earned clinical doctorate with commitment to pursue a PhD appropriate for teaching responsibilities and scholarly activity will be considered.
- * Minimum of 3 years' clinical experience
- * Contemporary expertise and experience across the lifespan are required with a preference for certification (e.g., PCS, GCS, NCS, CEEAA).
- * Current PT license; eligible for Physical Therapy licensure in North Dakota

Preferred Qualifications:

- * An academic doctorate in an appropriate field for teaching responsibilities
- * Experience in clinical research is preferred; however, the potential to develop a scholarly track is acceptable
- * Membership and involvement in professional associations

Responsibilities: Teaching in the areas of lifespan (pediatrics and geriatrics), motor control/neurorehabilitation, and other areas of department need; consistent scholarly activity and dissemination; and service to the department, school, university, and profession. Other duties include advising graduate and undergraduate students.
