The Doctor of Physical Therapy program is located at EWU Spokane on the Spokane/Riverpoint Campus. Our mission is to graduate entry-level physical therapists.

The primary role of the Director of Clinical Education (DCE) is to serve as a liaison between the Doctor of Physical Therapy Program, physical therapy students, and clinical education sites. The responsibilities of this position are to continue to develop, plan, coordinate, facilitate, administer, monitor, and measure the results of the clinical education program in coordination with academic and clinical faculty. In this role, the DCE will advocate for doctor of physical therapy students on clinical internships, communicate effectively with students and clinical instructors, and empower students to achieve their highest level of clinical expertise while participating in clinical internships.
