The Department of Physical Therapy at Texas State University is seeking faculty for the Round Rock, TX, campus at the assistant professor, associate professor, or professor rank for a nine-month tenure track appointment with possible summer employment annually. Rank and salary will be commensurate with the candidate's experience and qualifications. Faculty responsibilities include teaching, scholarship, student academic/research advising, and service in the entry-level DPT program. The ideal candidate will have university teaching that enhances the department's teaching, scholarship, and service across a variety of settings.

**Required Qualifications:** Earned doctorate in physical therapy or related field (terminal degree); licensed or eligible for licensure as a Physical Therapist by the State of Texas; at least 5 years of clinical practice experience and recent/current clinical engagement if employed in an academic setting; experience in teaching the musculoskeletal system; demonstrated ability to establish a program of scholarship; and record of accomplishments in scholarship, teaching, and service, appropriate for appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor (less than five years teaching), Associate Professor (minimum five years teaching), or Professor (minimum of 10 years teaching). The successful applicant will receive the appropriate rank and title based on university and department established standards.

**Description:** **Preferred Qualifications:** Demonstrated ability to collaborate with a variety of professionals within the university or clinical setting; demonstrated leadership in education and/or clinical practice; professional association membership with demonstrated active participation and commitment to service; experience conducting research, securing grant funding, and peer reviewed manuscript publication; and certification in one or more physical therapy specialties.
