The Department of Physical Therapy in the School of Health at Rehabilitation Sciences at the MGH Institute of Health Professions invites applications for two 12-month, full time Assistant Professor/Associate Professor positions to meet the growing needs of our physical therapy programs. Applicants for this position will ideally have expertise in at least one of the following areas: cardiovascular/pulmonary, exercise physiology, or musculoskeletal/orthopedics. Responsibilities include teaching, advising graduate students, scholarship in the applicant's area of interest, and committee service. Opportunities to participate in the design of new program initiatives, in combination with research and/or clinical practice, are available. A candidate should demonstrate evidence of promise as a scholar and educator. For candidates with potential for or a track record of external funding, start up packages to support research may be negotiable. Participation in professional activities is encouraged and supported.

QUALIFICATIONS

A candidate must have an academic doctorate (PhD, EdD, ScD, DSc) or a DPT with Board Certification. Prior academic or clinical teaching is necessary. Five years or more of clinical experience and eligibility for physical therapy licensure in Massachusetts is required. Minimum qualifications are negotiable for candidates with post-doctoral experience, a focused research program that complements our department and strong potential for extramural funding.

GRADUATE PROGRAMS IN PHYSICAL THERAPY

The Department of Physical Therapy offers both professional and post-professional degree programs. The professional program leads to a DPT degree and is well-respected for its visionary curriculum.
