- Earned academic doctoral degree (PhD, DSc, EdD) in physical therapy, exercise science, or related discipline. The DPT alone will not substitute for this requirement.

- Eligibility for Physical Therapy licensure in the State of Florida.
- Minimum 1 year relevant academic experience.

- For appointment as Associate Professor: minimum 5 years full-time appointed academic experience at Assistant Professor rank.

- Three years full-time academic experience as a faculty member in a Physical Therapist education program accredited by CAPTE.
- Established scholarly agenda with significant publication record and evidence of potential for extramural funding.
- Expertise in at least one of the following areas of teaching: pathophysiology, geriatrics, integumentary, cardiopulmonary, acute care, prosthetics/orthotics and/or musculoskeletal physical therapy management.
