Applicants with expertise in complex systems/clinical medical management, cardiopulmonary management, and acute care management are desired. Faculty will have opportunities to teach in areas of expertise as well as actively participate in scholarship, service, advising, and clinical practice. Preference will be given to those with prior academic experience.
