The Department of PT Education at Upstate Medical University invites applications from qualified candidates to join our faculty in a full-time, 12-month position at a level commensurate with experience. We are seeking a candidate to participate as an integral member of our clinical education team. Classroom and other teaching will be dependent on an applicant's areas of expertise and departmental needs. Involvement in service and in professional activities is expected at department, university, and national levels.

The successful candidate will have an academic doctoral degree (PhD, EdD, or DSc) and/or a Doctorate in Physical Therapy (DPT) and ABPTS board certification in place or with plans for completion. Doctoral candidates nearing completion are encouraged to apply. Candidates should demonstrate evidence of a commitment to clinical education. A minimum of 5 years experience as a licensed PT and 3 years as a clinical instructor are required. Experience in the role of Director of Clinical Education or as Site Coordinator of Clinical Education is preferred. We are seeking individuals who have a demonstrated commitment to or potential for teaching students and mentoring clinicians. Experience or interest in the use of simulation to support teaching and learning is desired. Strong interpersonal, communication, and organizational skills are required. NYS PT licensed (or eligible) required.

This position has administrative, teaching, service and scholarship responsibilities. Primary activities will include but are not limited to the following:

- Developing, monitoring, and refining the clinical education curriculum
- Facilitating quality learning experiences for students during clinical education (requires travel to clinical sites)
- Evaluating students' performance in classroom and clinic
- Identifying quality clinical sites
- Providing professional development to support clinical instructors

Description: The Department of PT Education uses innovative education, scholarship and service to inspire students and clinicians to be transformative physical therapy leaders. We have a committed faculty with excellence in teaching, professional service, clinical practice and scholarship.
