Reporting to the Dean of the College, the Associate Dean will provide management and oversight of campus operations including working with department chairs, facilitating interprofessional educational opportunities, and developing and maintaining collaborations with community entities and with partner university leadership at this shared campus. Graduate programs at the CHHS Northern Arizona University Phoenix Biomedical Campus currently include Athletic Training, Occupational Therapy, Physician Assistant Studies and Physical Therapy.
