The successful applicant will be responsible for developing an active research agenda, teaching in their area of expertise within an entry-level DPT program, and professional and university service. Faculty rank and salary commensurate with experience and academic credentials. The position is a 10-month appointment with research start-up funds available.

Required Credentials:

- Academic doctorate degree (DPT, PhD, EdD, ScD); PhD preferred
- Licensure as a Physical Therapist or eligibility for Physical Therapy licensure in the state of Indiana
- A record of success in research, teaching, and service in the applicant's area of expertise

- Demonstrated evidence of success in research through peer-reviewed publications and presentations and grants
- Developed programmatic line of research aligned with or complementary to the IU School of Health and Human Sciences
