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The Department of Physical Therapy at Augusta University (formerly known as Medical College of Georgia) in Augusta Georgia, invites applications for a full-time, 12-month position as a core faculty member of the Doctor of Physical Therapy program, rank of Assistant/Associate Professor.

We are seeking physical therapy educators with expertise in pediatrics and neurology. Responsibilities will include teaching in the candidate's area of expertise, maintaining a productive scholarly agenda, and providing service as required by the department, college or university. Participation in a faculty practice environment is also available.

Opportunities exist to participate in the department's developing pediatric residency program, and PhD in applied health sciences program. Tracks toward tenure or non-tenure are available and rank is negotiable based on the candidate's credentials and experiences. Candidates must be committed to student-centered education as well as working cooperatively with faculty and staff.

Qualifications: The ideal candidate will have a terminal academic degree (PhD, EdD, DSc) in physical therapy or in a related field. Candidates with board certification are preferred.

Applicants must have a minimum of 3 years of clinical/professional experience and must be eligible for physical therapy licensure in Georgia. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience. Effective communication and interpersonal skills with diverse populations and ability to work in a collaborative, problem-solving manner are required.

Conditions of Employment:

All candidates are required to successfully pass a background check review. For specific positions, the final candidate may be subject to a (pre-employment) physical and drug screen.

The final candidate will be required to provide proof of completed academic degree as well as post-secondary coursework in the form of original transcripts.
